Dear C & D Hauler:

On January 25, 2005 City Ordinance #4843 was adopted, regulating construction and demolition (C&D) debris roll-off refuse container service. There are a few basic purposes for this ordinance:

- To establish minimum standards for construction and demolition (C&D) debris collection and compliance of the same.
- To compensate the City for the wear and tear on City streets resulting from the collection and transportation of C&D in the City.
- To ensure C&D haulers are responsible business entities with minimum insurance limits.

The Municipal Services Department is responsible for administering this Ordinance, which requires that all contractors and property owners using these types of services use franchised haulers only.

The accompanying documentation contains the procedures and the form to be used to apply for a non-exclusive C&D franchise agreement in order to comply with this ordinance. It is important that you complete and submit the application form along with other required information as soon as possible so that we can issue your franchise and ensure uninterrupted collection services. Forms will also be available at the City of Boca Raton Building Department permit counter located on the first floor of City Hall, 201 W. Palmetto Park Road, Boca Raton, FL 33432. The completed application should be sent to the City of Boca Raton, Attn: Judi Ahern, Municipal Services, 201 W. Palmetto Park Road, Boca Raton, FL 33432-3795.
